

Wire Transfer Instructions

WIRE TRANSFERS

Wire transfers allow for the individualized transmission of funds from single individuals or entities to others while still maintaining the efficiencies associated with the fast and secure movement of money. By using a wire transfer, people in different geographic locations can safely transfer money to locales and financial institutions around the globe.

DOMESTIC TRANSFERS

Domestic Outgoing Wire Transfer

Provide the following information to BNH to send a domestic wire out:

- Receiving Bank Name
- Receiving Bank Physical Address
- Receiving Bank ABA/Routing number
- Beneficiary Name
- Beneficiary Physical Address
- Beneficiary Account Number
- Amount
- Any other information Invoice number, reference number, etc.

Please note, the best way to obtain wire transfer instructions is for the Beneficiary to contact their bank and obtain "Wiring Instructions." Please do not obtain information from your checks as this isn't always the proper information for routing wire transfers.

Domestic Incoming Wire Transfer

Provide the following information to the individual who will be wiring into your BNH account:

- Bank Name Bank of New Hampshire
- Bank Address 62 Pleasant Street, Laconia, NH 03246
- ABA/Routing Number 211770271
- Beneficiary Name
- Beneficiary Address
- Beneficiary Account Number

FOREIGN TRANSFERS

Foreign Outgoing Wire Transfer (US Dollar)

Provide the following information to BNH to send a foreign wire out:

- Receiving Bank Name
- Receiving Bank physical address (Not PO Box)*
- Receiving Bank identifying SWIFT Code
- Beneficiary Name
- Beneficiary Physical Address (Not PO Box)*
- Beneficiary Account Number
- Amount
- Any other information Invoice number, reference number, etc.

*Complete address information must be provided to comply with regulations. We are unable to initiate a foreign wire transfer without this information.

Foreign Incoming Wire Transfer (US Dollar)

Primary Method: If the sending bank allows a transfer without a Swift Code, provide the following information to the individual outside the United States who will be wiring into your BNH account:

- Bank Name Bank of New Hampshire
- Bank Address 62 Pleasant Street, Laconia, NH 03246
- ABA/Routing Number 211770271
- Beneficiary Name
- Beneficiary Physical Address
- Beneficiary Account Number
- Amount
- Any other information Invoice number, reference number, etc.

Secondary Method: If the sending bank requires a Swift Code, please call Bank of New Hampshire for instructions 24/7 at 1.800.832.0912.
