Visit the Saint-Gaudens National Historical Park and experience local artisans at work during live demonstrations of wood hand turning, glass blowing and pottery throwing. Take a step back in time at the Marsh-Billings Rockefeller National Historical Park and visit the working Billings Farm and Museum. Take in the sites of the Quechee Gorge, carved out by glacial activity 13,000 years ago and explore the baker's paradise of the King Arthur Baking Company.

Surrounded by the beauty and wonder of Vermont, this trip promises to be an unforgettable experience.



#### DAY 1 Arrive at Woodstock Inn • Saint-Gaudens National Park | Andrew Pearce Bowls | Simon Pearce Glass

Depart this morning for the quaint village of Woodstock, Vermont. Along the way to our destination, we will visit the Saint-Gaudens National Historic Park, a preservation of the home and studio of sculptor Augustus Saint-Gaudens. From there we will visit the studio of Andrew Pearce and experience the beauty in wood turning as local artisans create wooden bowls and live edge cutting boards. Our next stop will be Simon Pearce Glass to view a live glass blowing demonstration. Explore his creations displayed in the backdrop of a lovely mill building. Check in for two nights at the historic Woodstock Inn, centered in the heart of the village of Woodstock, just steps away from local shops and dining experiences. This evening, enjoy a welcome dinner along with your fellow travelers in the beautiful Garden Terrace of the Woodstock Inn. (L, D)

#### DAY 2 Explore Woodstock • Marsh-Billings-Rockefeller National Historic Park | Billings Farm | Farmhouse Pottery

After breakfast, we will venture off to the Marsh-Billings-Rockefeller Historic Park to tour the mansion and gardens surrounded by the 550-acre historic forest. Learn about the conservation and land stewardship of this property. There may even be an opportunity to see a 1960's era fallout shelter. Our next stop will be a visit to Billings Farm and Museum, regarded as one of the finest outdoor history museums in the country. Enjoy a horse-drawn carriage ride and participate in a butter making demonstration. Lunch will be provided on property today from a local favorite, The Village Butcher. This afternoon, we will head off to Farmhouse Pottery to step inside a working pottery studio to experience the art of throwing. Interact with local artisans during a live demonstration where timeless pieces are created by using hand techniques and pottery wheels. Afterward, we will return to the Woodstock Inn so that you may enjoy some free time this afternoon for shopping and dinner on your own. (B, L)

#### DAY 3 Depart for Home • Stop at Quechee Gorge | King Arthur Baking Company

Depart after breakfast. Enjoy a stop along the way to take in the splendor of Quechee Gorge, a gorge carved by glacial activity 13,000 years ago—a must-see! We will arrive at the King Arthur Baking Company, a baker's paradise, to get inspired by the scent of chocolate croissants and warm baguettes, pick up supplies and recipe cards in the store and stop by the bakery and café for a delightful lunch on your own. We will head for home this afternoon. (B)
